U.A. Local 682 Election of Officers - June 2015

A motion was passed at the January 14, 2015 regular monthly meeting that a request be made to General President William P. Hite at the General Office Annapolis Maryland that Local 682 Election of Officers for 2015 be conducted by way of “Mail in Ballot” only.

General President William P. Hite has subsequently approved the “Mail in Ballot” and has specifically stated that the June 2015 Election will be by **“Mail in Ballot only”**. There will be no walk in election.

Nominations for Election of Officers and the Election Committee for U.A. Local 682 will be conducted at the May 13, 2015 U.A. Local 682 regular monthly meeting at 8:00 P.M. to be held at the U.A. Local 682 Training Center, 1776 Sydney-Glace Bay Highway, Sydney, Nova Scotia.

Mail Balloting will begin on Friday, May 15, 2015 and Ballots must be returned and postmarked no later than Friday, June 26, 2015 .

The results of the election Mail Balloting will be counted and reported on Saturday June 27, 2015 at U.A. local 682 Training Center, 1776 Sydney-Glace Bay Highway beginning at 10:00 A.M.

In the event of a tie vote a runoff election will be conducted by Mail Balloting on June 30, 2015 and all ballots must be returned and postmarked no later than Friday July 24, 2015

The results of the runoff election mail Balloting will be counted and reported on Friday July 31, 2015 at the U.A. local 682 Training Center, 1776 Sydney Glace Bay Highway, Beginning at 10:00 A.M.

U.A. local 682 members accepting a nominations must be in good standing for 2 years prior to nomination.

RENEWAL OF WELDER BOILER BRANCH TICKETS

UA Local 682 have been renewing Boiler Branch tickets Since January 12, 2015 and will be renewing welding tickets at the U.A. Local 682 Training Center up to the end of April 2015 . Any welder who has tickets expiring during the year 2015 should renew there tickets before the end of April 2015. As of May 1, 2015 any other testing will be done on a need be basis when we have enough available for testing.

Fees for welding tickets are \$ 115.00 for F3-F4 \$ 115.00 For F6-F4 \$ 115.00 for F6-F5

Note Unless the welder has worked 300 hours in (ANY) UA Local Jurisdiction in 2014 .

OCCUPATION HEALTH AND SAFETY COURSES

OH&S COURSES have been ongoing since January 12, 2015 . Courses will be available until the end of April 2015 . Schedule for courses will be posted on our website. As of May 1, 2015 if your safety course expires training will be provided when there is enough participants. You must register for the course and will be contacted when the course will be offered.

RIGGING . UA National Rigging Certification is required in Alberta to pull a rigging slip . This training includes rigging theory and practical rigging training on approved pipe rack. This course will be scheduled when we have 12 or more Interprovincial Red Seal Steamfitters registered. You will have to register 3 weeks prior to course test date at a fee of \$ 150.00 to cover cost of course and books which must be paid on registration. Contact our office to Register.


