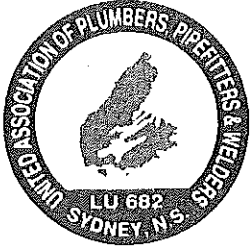

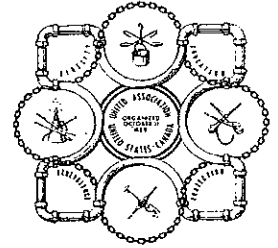

Re: Notice of Benefit Changes for the Health & Welfare Plan  
Date: June 1, 2015

The Trustees wish to advise all Local 682 Plumbers & Pipefitters Members that the following improvements are being made to the Benefit Plan **effective June 1, 2015.**

**For both the Active Members Regular Plan and the Senior Members Benefit Plan:**

**Major Medical Care Improvement:**

- The podiatry benefit will allow the duties of a Registered Podiatrist to be performed by a Registered Nurse or a Licensed Practical Nurse.
- **Employee and Family Assistance Program (EAP):**
- An Employee and Family Assistance Program is being added to your benefit plan. (a brochure will follow at a later date).

**Critical Illness Benefit:**

- A Critical Illness benefit is being added in the amount of \$10,000 per member up to age 65. This benefit reduces by 50% if you are age 65 or older. The benefit ceases at age 70. This benefit is for Members only (a detailed brochure will be sent at a later date).

**The following improvements pertain to the Seniors Benefit Plan Only:**

- Pharmacists will be allowed to verify a Senior Members Pharmacare coverage.

**Dental Plan Improvement:**

- The combined Dental maximum will increase from \$1,000 to \$2,000 per member.

**Life Insurance Benefit:** Basic Life will increase from \$5,000 to \$10,000 per member.
