Delegates to the 39th U.A. Convention

Election of Delegates to the 39th U.A. Convention to be held in San Diego, California beginning August 1 through August 5, 2016 inclusive.

Nominations for delegates to the 39th U.A. Convention will be accepted at our February 10, 2016 monthly meeting at 8:00 P.M. Nominations for Election Committee will take place on the same night.

Election for delegates to the 39th U.A. Convention will be conducted at UA local 682 Training Center, 1776 Sydney-Glace Bay Highway on March 12, 2016 from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

Runoff if necessary on April 9, 2016 at UA Local 682 Training Center from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

Only those members in good standing during the month of March prior to the date of the convention will be counted.

No members shall be eligible as a delegate or alternate unless they have been in good standing of the local for at least 2 years continuously, previous to the election.

Members eligible to vote must be in good standing 1 year prior to election.
